Thank you all the staff who came along to support us, especially to our Mascot, Sumaya, who did an excellent job!

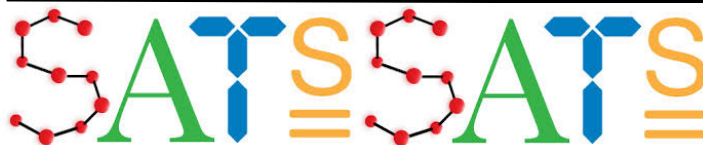

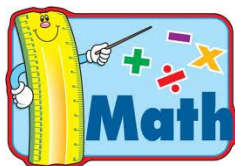


Year 1

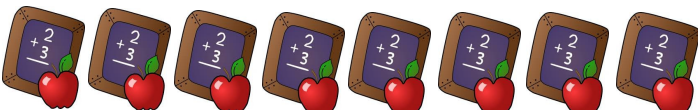
YEAR 1

It has been a very exciting half term in Year 1! In English the children have been looking at Film Narrative and they have used lots of ad-

venturous vocabulary to write setting descriptions, character descriptions and their very own story. They have been exploring the film "Shrek 2" where they looked at different settings and the character. In maths we have been exploring number



and the operations of addition and subtraction. We have been applying our knowledge of tens and units and using number lines and 100 squares to add and subtract numbers.



In Science we have been exploring sound. We have investigated the different sources of sound and the different ways that we can make sound using musical instruments to explore loud and quiet sounds.



Year 3

This half term Year 3 have been learning to write their own adventure stories. The children have looked at different characters in stories as George's



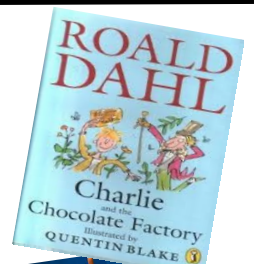
Marvellous Medicine and films such as Mulan to help with their character descriptions. In maths the pupils have been

learning about number based word problems, angles and measure and this will continue for the rest of the academic year.



Year 4

This half term Year 4 have been learning how to write stories set in imaginary worlds. They have researched lots of different



fantasy stories including "The Wizard of Oz", "Charlie and the Chocolate Factory", "Alice in Wonderland" and "Narnia". These have all been fascinating and the children have just finished writing their own imaginary world story.

Our Artist in Residence — Andrew Tims

Our Artist-in-Residence Andrew Tims has been

working on a weekly basis with children from across the school to develop



artwork linked to the topics they are studying in the classroom. The completed artwork from each Year Group will be

framed and exhibited in the newly refurbished corridor spaces directly outside the children's classrooms.



"Around the World in 40 Days"

Our pupils have been investigating elements of the whole school topic "Around the World in 40 Days" with each year group focusing on a particular country:-

Reception: Pupils in Reception have created a series of woven planets, linked to their year group 'Space' theme using a range of materials including wool, cotton thread, pipe cleaners and buttons.

Year 1: Africa, specifically animals native to Africa.

Year 2: China, with a focus on the patterns found on traditional Chinese ceramic vases and plates.

Year 3: Greece and Greek Mythical Creatures

Year 4: Travelling around the world, including the clothing they would wear and the items they would need.



Year 5 pupils have been investigating portraiture, specifically the lines and shapes that makeup our facial features. **Year 6** pupils explored the local area of



Newtown, specifically the shapes, patterns and colours that appear in the landscape viewed from their classroom window.

Cake Sale



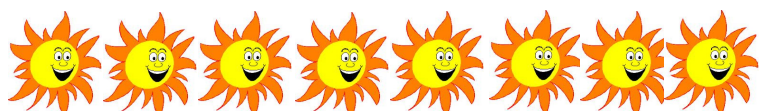
