You must call Jadieal or Darnish beforehand. They will take details from you about your family and how many people require food parcels. Jadieal or Darnish will then let you know which time and day your parcels will be ready for collection.



Salma Food Bank are a **24-HOUR** emergency food bank (*emergency means you have no food to eat that day*) located in Smethwick and cover the West Midlands area. They provide families and individuals a direct lifeline to food and it is delivered to your doorsteps. The project is OPEN 365 DAYS.

To access a parcel: simply text/ phone 07767164246, or go online to register at www.salma-foodbank.org.

A volunteer will contact you and take some personal details and complete a comprehensive assessment with you over the phone, once they have established that you are in an emergency situation for food, they will either deliver a parcel to you that day.

Please note this service is running limited due to the COVID19 outbreak, we are ONLY dealing with people with families, over 65 & extremely vulnerable until further notice, there will be no exception to this rule.
