This term, children will be revisiting Phase 5 phonic sounds and alternative graphemes.

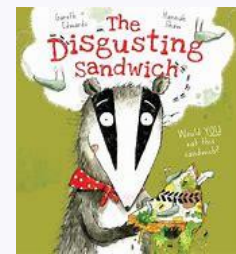

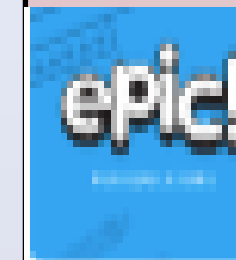
D&T – Beach hut This project teaches children about making and strengthening structures, including different ways of joining materials.

How can you help at home?

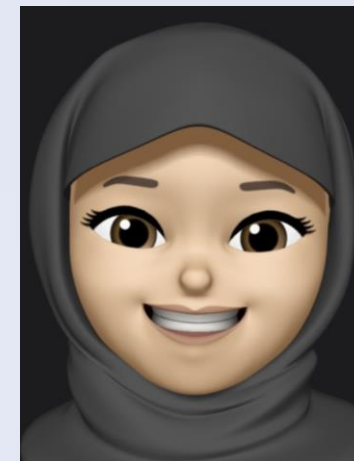
- ❖ Please listen to your child read **everyday!** In the back of each book are questions to support your child with comprehension; this helps to see children's understanding of the book.
- ❖ Epic reading! Free online books.
- ❖ Play online games such as TTRS and hit the button. These support with Maths fluency.
