The children will also get a visit from a real-life archaeologist that will come into school, to share artefacts relating to the topic. Throughout this project the children will have many practical opportunities to explore how different types of rock are formed, through to making their own volcanoes.

How can you help at home?

Read with your child **every day**. The more words that children read/hear, the better they will perform in all areas of the curriculum. You can support them by asking questions like "What do you think will happen next? Why do you think the character said that? What does that word mean?" Encourage them to use an online dictionary to look up words they have never seen before.
