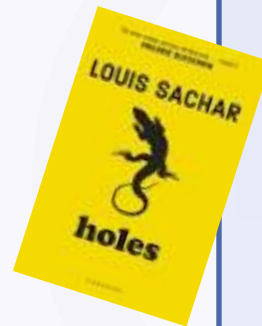

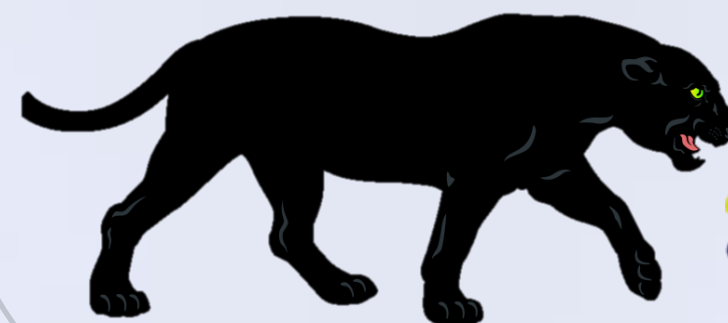

In science this term we will be exploring the unit: Animals including Humans.

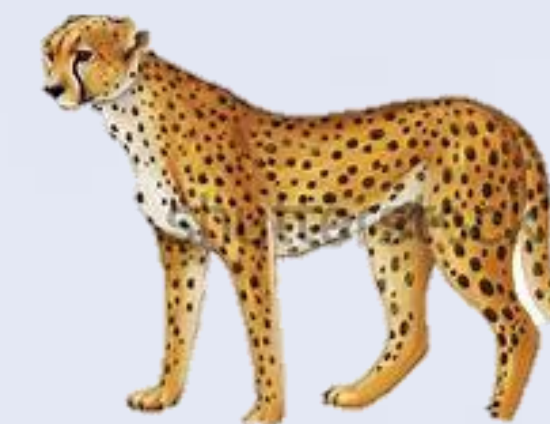

Wednesday 11th May – Arithmetic and Reasoning 2

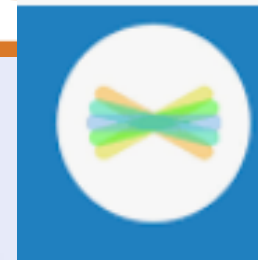
Thursday 12th May – Reasoning 3
